You will use your own stash to make the blocks. Please read the pattern for color choices you will need to use from your stash. The block will be submitted the month after you receive the pattern (September block pattern is due in October) and you will receive a raffle ticket for the drawing of the blocks at the meeting. The best part is, if vou turn in two blocks you will receive three tickets! Your odds get better... If you turn in four blocks, you will receive six tickets. as you cut. This is easier than trying to read the small
printed instructions in magazines or books.
