Annelle's OriginalsWool Appliqués


Our March Guild meeting will feature Annelle's Originals presenting a trunk show and demonstration on wool appliqués.

And some of our members favorite rulers are....

June Tailor's Shape Cut ruler definitely! I love being able to cut 2" or 3" squares so quickly and without having to move fabric around...by far the best! **Cindy Smith**

Olaf 6" x 24". It is clear and you can see the fabric clearly below it, not like Omnigrid which is yellow and hard to see through.

Sue DeCamp

My favorite ruler is any of the Creative Grid rulers. Two years ago my goal was to improve my quilting accuracy. This started with my cutting. Pam Kosa recommended Creative Grid. I tried one and was very impressed with the anti-move circles on the back. I also like the very thin lines on the ruler. This may be a disadvantage to those with vision problems. I have since replaced (one at each quilt show) all my most frequently used rulers with Creative Grid (they are that good). I have also had friends borrow my Creative Grid rulers and have since purchased only this brand. I have found it worth the money.

I love the strip piecing ruler by June Tailor. It makes cutting strips quick and easy.
