# November "Stitching in Hope" Workshop

### Sashiko Embroidery, Presented by Jacqui Clarkson

Come and learn the techniques of the different regions of Japan in Sashiko embroidery. It is often used in combination with patchwork or appliqué in order to create more complex designs. We will share the day not only learning the history, but creating your own piece which you can incorporate into a quilt or create a pillow or part of a tote. The kit includes the Sashiko fabric with a pattern on it, your Japanese needle, Japanese thread and thimble to help you recreate in a similar manor to the Japanese.

We will learn the correct method of stitching and the reasons behind their methods. It will be a very soothing and productive day.
