
EVENING STAR QUILTERS GUILD THE STITCH LINE


2017 QOV BOM INDIAN HATCHETS (8" finished block)


BRING TO FEB. MEETING

Blocks should be scrappy.

(2) red 4 ¹/₂" squares
(2) blue 4 ¹/₂" squares
(8) white 2 ¹/₂" squares

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each white square. Place a white square in two opposite corners of each red and blue square. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press toward red and blue squares.





2. Join top blue unit to red unit, press seam to blue; repeat with bottom units. Join units to make block pictured below, nestling seams. Block should measure 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", so it finishes to 8" when joined.



3. Make as many as you like- the more blocks I collect, the more QOV I can make! This one will get a wide white border with appliquéd stars.
