


ESQG Name Tag Rotary Cutting Directions



Cutting:

Use any choice of fabrics

Background fabric:

1 center square - 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

4 corner squares - 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"

Triangles: Cut 4 rectangles - 2-1/2" x 1-1/2"






(Yes, cut rectangles!)


Star Point Fabric:

Cut 8 squares - 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"




Sewing:

1. To make star points, draw a diagonal line on **wrong side**→ of each star point square.
2. Take a background rectangle and place one star square **RIGHT SIDE DOWN** on top of one end of the rectangle. Please note the direction on the diagonal line in the diagram.
3. Sew on the diagonal line. Be careful to sew exactly as you can from corner to corner.
4. Cut off the corner 1/4" **ABOVE** the line or on the side of the line toward the center.
5. Press triangle out to fill in for the cut off corner.
6. Take another star square and place at opposite end of background rectangle, right sides together. Note direction of diagonal line and that there is a slight overlap of the first star point.
7. Sew exactly on diagonal line. Follow steps 4 and 5 above. Make **FOUR** of these sets for star points. Each should measure 1-1/2" x 2-1/2".
8. Sew a 1-1/2" background square to each end of the two sets of the star points made above.
9. Sew a star point to each side of the 2-1/2" background square.
10. Sew the three sections together to match the diagram above to make the name tag.
11. Write or embroider you full name inside the center square.
12. Use batting and backing to complete the name tag. You may or may not choose to quilt it. Finish the edge as you like.
